- 11. The Committee shall arrange for at least one Exhibition a year.
- 12. The Club can in no way be held responsible for any loss or damage to works exhibited at or outside normal club venues, or equipment presented to any activity of the Club.
- 13. The Committee may remove from the roll of members any members whose conduct is unseemly. Such members shall have no claim for any subscription or entrance fee paid.
- 14. All cheques drawn on behalf of the Society to be signed by any two of the following the Hon Treasurer, Hon. Secretary and/or Chairman.
- 15. Expenses, other than petty cash, incurred by the Club must have an official suppliers invoice submitted to the Hon. Treasurer and must be settled by the Hon. Treasurer with a cheque drawn on the Club's building society account.
- 16. Notice of resignation of any Committee member prior to the Annual General Meeting must be submitted to the Hon. Secretary in writing.
- 17. Extra Ordinary General Meetings may be convened by the Hon. Secretary, if requested by at least twelve members or by the Committee.
- 18. In the event of the Club being wound up, the property and assets of the Club shall not belong to any member but an inventory taken and the proceeds given to a worthy charity and/or local art club(s) nominated by the Committee.

12. All exhibitors are expected to assist with stewarding, or setting up, or collecting monies or any other activity involved with running the exhibition for a short time.

NOTES:

- a: Canvases with deep box sides are often displayed without frames. We do accept these pictures, on the condition that the sides of the picture have been painted and are presented in an acceptable form.
- **b:** Acrylic, oil or similar paintings, unframed, on canvas or board, are not considered to be portfolio sketches and paintings, and may not be submitted in this category.
- c: Members should be aware of copyright law. You must not put your name to work that has been copied from a picture, painting or photo belonging to another person, unless you have contacted that person or their representatives, and requested use of their copyright. You may be charged for the use of copyright. If you have followed a step by step painting in a magazine, or DVD or similar, you must credit the other artist.

The above note is only a brief description of copyright, and does not cover all circumstances. Once a copyright exists, it is in force for 70 years after death.

Ashford Art Club Exhibition Rules

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY TO ENSURE TROUBLE FREE HANGING

- 1. MEMBERS ONLY may submit up to 8 exhibits at £1 per exhibit.
- 2. <u>COMMISSIONS ON SALES</u> The purchase price, less the clubs 10% commission will be paid by cheque or cash to the respective exhibitor at the following week's meeting.
- 3. <u>MEDIA</u>. Paintings may be of any medium. oils, water colour. pastel, pen and ink, collage, etc.
 - ALL PICTURES SUBMITTED MUST BE MEMBERS OWN WORK. COPIES AND REPRODUCTIONS OF OTHER ARTISTS' WORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTABLE. (See note c below).
- 4. <u>PICTURES MUST NOT HAVE BEEN HUNG AT PREVIOUS ASHFORD</u> EXHIBITIONS
- 5. PRESENTATION. Only oil or acrylic paintings that include the sides of the canvas as an integral part of the overall image will, at the artist's risk, be displayed without a frame. (See note a below) All other pictures must be suitably framed; in the interest of safety clip frames are not permitted.
 - Please ensure that all fittings for hanging are securely fixed and are capable of supporting the weight of the frame. D rings or eyelets should be inserted a third of the way down from the top of the frame and a taught wire or picture cord between them.

Each exhibit must have a label securely affixed to the <u>back</u>. The following details to appear on the labels.

- (a) Name and Address of Member
- (b) Title of Exhibit and Medium
- (c) Price or N.F.S. (Not for Sale)

When submitting work it would be preferable if a title is given.

- ENTRY DATE Please fill in both forms and give or send them to the Treasurer to arrive not later than the entry date. This date will be announced at our weekly meetings before the exhibition.
- 7. On receipt of your completed forms you will be given a NUMBERED STICKER for each entry submitted.
 - This must be placed on the lower RIGHT HAND corner of your picture. The top form will be returned to you for reference.
- 8. <u>HANGING EVENING</u>. All exhibits. properly labelled and numbered, must be brought to **the place of the exhibition within the required time frame.**

THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY EXHIBIT IT THINKS UNSUITABLE.

- 9. THE COLLECTION OF PAINTINGS AT CLOSE OF EXHIBITION
- (a) No pictures are to be removed from the exhibition before the exhibition is closed.

- (b) Members or their representatives MUST collect their exhibits within the required time frame. Please DO NOT remove sold pictures from the stands.
- (c) Purchasers of paintings will be informed of their collection time.
- 10. <u>PORTFOLIO OF MEMBERS' SKETCHES AND PAINTINGS</u>. Members may submit up to 10 unframed sketches and paintings suitably mounted. (See note b)

Paintings in this category, must be suitably mounted and each individual picture covered with a polypropylene bag or film. The committee will not accept paintings covered in polythene sheeting or cling film.

Price stickers to be placed on the right hand corner of exhibits.

Members name and address must be entered on the back of each entry. There is a small fee of 50p per painting or sketch.

11. <u>CRAFTS</u>. Members may submit up to three craft items at £1 per exhibit. Please use separate Craft Entry Form. All entries will be exhibited at the discretion of the committee. Tables may be hired at £5 per table with no maximum number of items.
